Watercolours – All Levels

Description:

The chief characteristic of watercolour is its transparency and in 'pure' watercolour painting this is exploited to the full. Unlike the painter in oils who can lay lighter paint over dark tones, the water colourist must work through from the lightest tones to the darkest. It is the transparent pigment which gives pictures in watercolor the brilliance and sparkle which sets them apart from other styles of painting. This medium can be enjoyed by all abilities ie Beginners, Intermediate or Advanced. I will guide you step by step from still life or pictures, depending on preference.

Materials:

- Watercolor sheets, boards or pad (A3 or A4)
- B or 2B pencil
- Putty rubber or soft normal white rubber
- Palette to mix colours [plastic]
- A studio set of water colours is advisable. (Recommended: Cotman [Winsor & Newton]. Even though these are a little more expensive, the more reputable sets will retain their qualities for a lot longer)
- Brushes – 3 or 4 brushes in variable sizes would be fine to start with
- An optional use of pen and ink will also be introduced to give an extra edge/sharpness
- Masking fluid

If students are unsure regarding materials it is recommended that you ask for guidance before purchasing. I am very happy to guide you in making your purchases from the Art shop which is on DUCTAC premises.
