Type of course: this is a 4 weeks syllabus course

Description:

This course is for sculptors wishing to expand their knowledge using a variety of sculpture techniques and materials to develop skills and provide a basis for creative development aimed at gaining sensitivity in the composition, observation, and analysis of sculptural form.

The purpose of this course is to develop skills in the representation of the human form and understanding of its creative use in sculpture. Students will be introduced to universal truths about the body regarding proportion, anatomy, and geometric construction.

This course will be customized according to each student's specific level. The structure of the course is based upon three developmental levels; the duration for each level is 4 weeks.

- Level 1-pre-intermediate: you will learn how to work in detail the human face features (nose, eye, mouth, ear)
- Level 2-intermediate: you will learn how to model a human face, on the armature
- Level 3-advanced: you will learn how to portray human movement: a human figure dancing, sitting, walking etc.; you will have the opportunity to do many figures in different postures, dressed in different kind of costumes.

Course layout:

- A short lecture, about the human figure and sculpted faces from different art period (images, related ideas, descriptions)
- Technical tips
- Your previous experience in working with clay will be used and linked to the new techniques like wedging, coiling, pinching, shaping

When students have completed the Sculpture course, they will know and be able to:

- Observe and describe visual qualities that characterize the sculpted human form
- Solve visual problems
- Communicate ideas three-dimensionally
- Interpret the relationships of balance, harmony, proportion and movement of three-dimensional forms
- Develop proficiency in handling tools related to sculpture

Materials:

- You have to get a sketch book with you at least A4 size and a soft pencil, B preferred and an eraser
- 2 grocery or laundry bags (for storing the works)
- Tools: 15 AED per set (to be purchased from the tutor), can be used for any of the session preferred
