## GALLERY OF LIGHT INTERNSHIPS

The Gallery hosts a rotating programme of curated exhibitions, arts education projects and for funding purposes hosts private hire events. Situated within DUCTAC a multi-disciplinary arts centre the Gallery is adjacent to theatres, dance studios, screening rooms an art-store and relaxing open-air cafe.

The Gallery internship scheme provides students and recent graduates with practical experience in arts management and administration.

Interns work with staff members across the arts centre on real projects that include professional development in: artist liaison / arts sales / bookings / brand communication / curatorial decision making / data management / front of house / fundraising / installing and de-installation / invigilating / research / workshop assistance.

Interns must be 16+ and able to work a minimum of 12 hours per week. Internships start throughout the year.

The Gallery accepts students with academic credit requirements and dedicates a staff-member to mentoring such applicants.
